## Installation:

- 1. Measure the latch line (see fig. 1).
  - Measure the distance between the face of the door jamb and the face of the door latch. This is the vertical latch distance.
  - b. Measure the vertical latch distance on the door jamb from the face of the door jamb. At that point, draw a vertical line. This is the latch line.
- 2. Measure the center line (see fig. 2).
  - Measure the distance from the floor to the center of the door latch. Ignore the location of the deadlatch pin when taking measurements.
  - b. Measure the same distance as above along the inside of the door jamb. This is the center line.
- 3. Align the included mounting template to the latch and center lines (see fig. 3)
- Using the template as a guide, cut into the door jamb to a depth of <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (19mm).
   NOTE: If cutting into a wooden door, use a chisel to knock out a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" (3mm) deep cut as shown on the template.
- 5. Using two of the included machine screws, affix the mounting tabs to the inside of the door jamb (see fig. 4).
- Connect the two wires from the access control or egress device, e.g. keypad, push-button switch, push-bar, etc. to the door strike wires. Polarity is not important.
- Conceal all wires in the door frame. Use two of the included machine screws to mount the unit to the mounting tabs. Adjust as needed to ensure the door closes smoothly (see fig. 5).
   NOTE: Intermittent duty use > 20 seconds per cycle.
